Junior Golf

Golf is meant to be played as a game. You must always practice honesty and sportsmanship to the fullest. The Crestwicke Junior Program teaches you to have fun and respect the game and the people who play it. Our goal for the program is to teach the fundamentals of putting, the short game and the full swing. We also instruct in the rules of golf and on-course etiquette. This will not only enhance your child as a golfer, but as an individual as well. Parents play an important part in the success of the Junior Golf Program. Each Tuesday, please check your child in at the registration table. The registration table will be located on the patio in front of the Putting Green . Each golfer should then be ready to proceed to the practice area to begin their lesson. All golfers are required to play with their own equipment and have proper labels on their golf bag and clubs. **Parents that have children in the 3 and 6-hole divisions are asked to participate as “drivers”**. We encourage that the children walk while playing but can ride between holes if necessary.

The following are general guidelines for the Junior Golf divisions. Any child can be moved up or down in the divisions on the recommendation of the parent or golf staff. (Ex: If your 11 y/o is new to the game, the professional recommendation would be for the Pin Seekers Division. This will make your child feel most comfortable with a combination of kids that are similar ability level as well as age.)

Greens Keepers (9-Hole)

Holes: 9

Ability: Advanced

Tees: Red

Age: 11+

Pin Seekers (6-Hole)

Holes: 6

Ability: Intermediate

Tees: 200 yards (Blue) Plate

Age: 9-10

Wee Linkers (3-Hole)

Holes: 3

Ability: Beginner

Tees: 150 yards (White) Plate

Age: 7-8

Pint-Sized Putters

Holes: Putting green, Chipping green, and Range

Ability: None

Age: 5-6

Pint Sized

This group is generally 5 and 6-year old's and is geared for children just beginning to learn the game of golf. Fundamentals, safety, etiquette and the short game will be taught. This group does not go out on the course. The children will have 6 weeks of lessons starting June 11th through July 16th.

Camp Week

The Junior Golf Program starts with three days of instruction during camp week June 4th, 5th, and 6th. The schedule for camp week will differ from the regular Tuesday schedule. All divisions except for the Pint-Sized Putters are involved in camp week. Kids will be broken into two age groups.

Group "A" -Kids 11 and over

Registration: 8:15am Golf – 8:30 - 9:30

Group "B" -Kids 7 to 10

Registration: 9:45am Golf – 10:00 - 11:00

Regular Tuesdays

Instruction times on Tuesday will run from 8:00 am to approximately 11:10 am. The instruction time that the child signs up for will be their assigned time for the duration of the Junior Program. The lessons will run for 40 minutes. After the lessons the children will be able to go out and play except for the Pint Size Putters. This is an opportunity to take what they have learned from the instruction to the golf course.

Pint Sized Putters: 10:30 am -11:10am

REGULAR TUESDAY DATES

June 11, 18, 25 and July 2, 9, 16.

July 23rd is the Junior Club Championship.

All Junior Golf Participants are automatically registered for the Championship day.

Pint Sized Putters are finished on July 16.

Dress Code

Dress that is appropriate to a Country Club setting is required. The Crestwicke junior dress code is as followed: No denim or bathing attire.

Parent-Child Championship

July 14th

This is designed as a fun day of competition. It is an alternate shot format with 3, 6, and 9 hole divisions. All parents and kids will play a full 9 holes, beginning at 4:00pm followed by pizza and soft drinks. Signup will be in the grill.

Junior Club Championship

July 23rd

The Junior Club Championship will have separate divisions for the boys and girls in the 3 Hole, 6 Hole and 9 Hole groups. Awards for the junior golf winners will follow the tournament.

JUNIOR GOLF WALKERS - 3/6 HOLLERS JOB DESCRIPTION

1. ARRIVE 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO TEE TIMES.
2. REPORT TO THE REGISTRATION TABLE FOR INSTRUCTIONS.
3. GOLF CARTS ARE AVAILABLE AT NO CHARGE. CHILDREN MUST WALK WHILE PLAYING GOLF. GOLFERS MAY BE GIVEN A RIDE BETWEEN HOLES AND GOLFERS MAY BE GIVEN RIDES AFTER FINISHING THEIR ROUNDS BACK TO THE PRO SHOP. PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL KIDS ARE SAFE AND SECURE IN THE CARTS.
4. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COUNTING STROKES.
5. THE MAXIMUM STROKES PRIOR TO REACHING THE GREEN IS 7. AFTER 7 STROKES, THE JUNIOR IS TO PICK UP THE BALL AND DROP IT ON THE GREEN A FAIR LENGTH FROM THE HOLE. THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PUTTS IS 4.
6. KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU.
7. JUNIORS ARE ALLOWED ONLY ONE BALL IN THE WATER AND ARE TO THEN PROCEED TO THE DROP AREA ON THE OTHER SIDE.
